## **Improving Your Weavepole/Contact Performances \$50**

**Wednesday, April 7 (5:00pm-6:30pm) or Wednesday April 14 (5:30pm-7:00pm)**

Slow weaves? Creepy contacts? Leaping off the aframe? Missing the entries? All of these common issues and many more will be addressed in this workshop. Dogs must be competing at the Novice Level or above.

## **Finding Lines & Handler Paths (Excellent Level) \$60**

## **Teaching Your Dog the Patterns of Agility (Novice/Open Level) \$50**

**Tuesday, April 13 10:30-12 noon**

Pinwheels, serpentines, threadles, 270's, 180's, and 360's, appear quite often on the agility course. This workshop will take you through the steps of teaching your dog the skills needed to perform these patterns while maintaining consistency on your part.

## **Teaching Your Dog To Turn \$50**

**Wednesday 14 (7:00pm-8:30pm)**

Teach your dog to wrap uprights tightly and efficiently while also keeping the bars up! Tight turning dogs avoid off-courses, safely turn their bodies, and shave seconds off of their course times. This workshop is appropriate for puppies 6 months or older as well as seasoned competition dogs that could benefit from the exercises.
