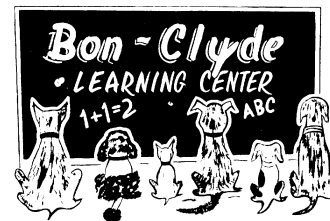


Agility Handling Workshops
