Fantastic Fundamentals - <All levels>

Saturday, June 13 8:00am-12:00pm

This seminar will address the crucial elements of training, handling, and motivating the agility dog. Whether you are a novice preparing for your first trial or an experienced team, you will develop and/or fine tune the skills needed for a solid foundation. Working participants should be comfortable but not necessarily proficient on all obstacles.

This seminar will offer the same types of challenges as the Saturday Height Challenged Dog seminar, but at the Excellent level.

Analysis in Action - <Open/Excellent>

Sunday, June 14 1:00pm-5:00pm

Finally a seminar to simulate the show environment! Bring your running shoes and be prepared to put your handling and course analysis skills to the test. Learn to analyze the strengths and weaknesses of your runs in a fast-paced, high-energy format with an emphasis on running full courses just at you would at a trial.

He has competed as a finalist at numerous AKC Agility National Championships and represented the USA at the 2007 European Open. Shine is looking forward to an illustrious career in agility and made his debut in Europe at the 2008 European Open.
