Obedience, Rally and Breed Handler and Scent Work Classes

Puppy Kindergarten:

This class is generally for puppies between the ages of 12 weeks to 6 months old. A few of the topics covered in the course will be socializing your puppy, nipping and bite inhibition, beginning obedience (sit, down, stay, and come), discussion on nail clipping and teeth cleaning, plus use of small obstacles for confidence building. Puppies must have Rabies vaccine to attend classes.

Beginners Obedience:

This class is for dogs 6 months and over. The course will consist of teaching the sit, down, stay, and come when called and walking on a loose leash, along with control and manners. All exercises will be done on a leash.

Perfecting Skills:

Dogs and their handlers will continue work started in the Beginners Obedience class. Emphasis will be placed on helping your dog learn control, developing relationships, and improving existing skills. Learn skills to prepare for Foundation Skills for Agility and Rally Obedience and prepare your dog for Canine Good Citizen and "Bright and Beautiful" therapy dog certification

Introduction /Novice Rally:

This class will focus on preparing dogs for competition Rally Obedience. Basic heeling and exposure to all AKC Novice Rally Obedience signs will be covered. Dogs should have completed the Perfecting Skills class but no experience with Rally Obedience is necessary.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS: DOGS MUST BE ABLE TO FOCUS AND WALK ON A LOOSE LEASH ON YOUR LEFT SIDE, SIT, DOWN ,STAND AND STAY. Must be non reactive to other dogs.

Novice/Intermediate Rally:

This class will continue to expand your dog's skills in Novice Rally and introduce signs and skills for Intermediate Rally. You and your dog will be prepared for competition in Novice and Intermediate Rally.

Breed Handler:

This class is designed to prepare both handler and dog for competing in the conformation ring. This class is now held in conjunction with our regular classes. Please mark your calendars.

Introduction to Scent Work:

Dogs will be imprinted on Birch odor and learn the foundation skills needed to complete in Scent Work. Dogs will need to have good manners and be able to work around other dogs. Basic obedience is a must . Class can be repeated if needed.

Intermediate Scent work class:

Dogs must have taken the Introduction class or equivalent. Dogs will be introduced to Anise and Clove odors. They will learn more advanced skills needed , and will be working with all three odors. Class can be repeated for more skills work.

Excellent Scent work class:

Dogs must have completed Introduction and Intermediate scent work classes. They may require the Instructors approval. Dogs will work on all three odors and Cypress. Skills will be taught to prepare the dog for the higher levels, and will work on problem solving and reliability in searching.
